





Exolon® multi UV Onda Installations

Exolon® multi UV Onda is designed to create skylights in combination with glass fibre reinforced panels or for continuous skylights. The installation requires dedicated holes on the top of wave's crest which allow the positioning of screws corresponding the purlins of the supporting structure and the thermal expansion of polycarbonate panels.

The screws used for fixing should be provided with proper gaskets to prevent possible water infiltration. For slopes greater than 6 m in length, it recommends the use of more overlapped sheets with a depth of at least 200 mm overlap.


The placement of a PE adhesive gasket between the two overlapped sheets is always recommended.


Exolon® multi UV Onda are supplied thermosealed at the ends reducing the water/dirty infiltration but it will not

prevent the moisture formation inside the air chambers of the **Exolon® multi UV Onda** which is a natural phenomenon linked to the property of polycarbonate material.


The presence of small holes on the edge can't be considered a defect that can be closed with a thin layer of silicone compatible with the polycarbonate.

Screws must be installed on each crest with the proper gasket and metal ring, the distance between two crests is 177 mm.







Exolon® multi UV Greca 5G Installations

The Exolon® multi UV Greca 5G is designed to create roofs to the entire slope (from ridge to eaves) in combination with common insulated panels. The installation requires dedicated holes on the top of panel's crest which allow the positioning of screws corresponding the purlins of the supporting structure and the thermal expansion of polycarbonate panels.

Consequently, the screws used for fixing should be provided with proper gaskets to prevent possible water infiltration.

For roofs longer than 6 m in length, it recommends the use of more overlapped sheets with a depth of at least 200 mm overlap. Polyethylene adhesive gasket (or suitable for PC material) between the two overlapped sheets is always recommended.


Exolon® multi UV Greca 5G will be fixed at all purlins: If the purlins distance is higher than 1,500 mm, we suggest supporting the product with an additional fixing in the middle.

Exolon® multi UV Greca 5G are supplied thermosealed at the ends reducing the water/dirty infiltration but it will not prevent the moisture formation inside the air chambers of the **Exolon® multi UV Greca 5G** which is a natural phenomenon linked to the property of polycarbonate material.


Small holes on the edge can't be considered a defect and can be closed with a thin layer of silicone compatible with the polycarbonate.


In ridge and eaves should be installed the specific PE spacer to close the space below (gutter) 7 and above (top) of the shape 6.
